Forced to Live in a Car



A disabled Flagler County resident's rental was condemned due to excessive mold. The landlord was unwilling to mitigate the situation so the tenant was forced to move into her car. With the help of her outreach navigator, she was referred to resources within her community to assist her with locating food/meal sources, alternative health and wellness services, and linkage to the coordinated entry system. Through VFCCH's continuum of care partnerships with local agencies, she was referred to an affordable permanent supportive housing unit and was able to exit her car.
