This project will provide "scholarships" for students unable to afford required participation fees and will cover additional expenses required to continue the athletic opportunities at NSB High School since funding for sports was lost as a result of budget cuts this year.

Long Term Impact: This event will provide safe and wholesome activities in our aesthetically pleasing environment for all citizens of the community. We anticipate this to become an ANNUAL EVENT to allow the athletic programs of the New Smyrna Beach High School to continue. The PTSA will realize their VISION: "Connecting Community Partners to support initiatives that promote student success". The tournament will be a testament to the collective successes of our students, parents, teachers, coaches, administrators and citizens of the community.
