Description: A large size diaper/toilet tissue and personal hygiene product drive to benefit our clients of all faiths in the community. Most needed are large size 4, 5, 6 diapers.

Volunteers at sponsoring agency buy, collect and deliver the requested items to Catholic Charities on Make a Difference Day.

Who will benefit: Food stamps do not cover diapers, toilet tissue and personal hygiene products. Many times we cannot help those who need these items, due to lack of donations to us. Our budget doesn't permit us to purchase anything except food. Household food budgets are stretched due to household emergencies, etc.

Long Term Impact: The fact that somebody notices that food stamps doesn't provide for toilet tissue, diapers, etc., provides hope that we understand their plight. We provide compassion, empathy with the difficulties the families face. This communicates that "we believe in you." Each child needs to be fed, and also needs toilet tissue after!
