Project Information

Description: Our needs are diapers, size 1-4, pull-ups, baby wipes, baby lotions & shampoos, new clothing 3mos through 3T. Young single mothers going to school and changing the lives for herself and her child will be able to supplement her resources with the donations. Donations would be distributed by the case worker during their visitations.

Volunteers will collect items described above.

Who will benefit: The Road to Independence program provides services to 18-24 and many of the clients seek help for diapers and baby items. As the young adults strive to change the lives for a better future through continued education or improved job skills they are the only support their young children have. We chose this project so that the children of former foster youth do not suffer the same fate as their parents. The proposed drive would help case workers monitor the well being of the child, give the tools needed to create a nurturing environment and encourage parenting skills to those that have never been shown how to nurture and parent.

Long Term Impact: Through assistance and support these young mothers will grow to be the parent they never had, enabling them to stop the cycle of abuse & neglect, one child at a time!
