
Over half (53.25%) of all households in Volusia in which a person with a disability resides are ALICE or below

95% of all ALICE individuals with disabilities in Volusia are rent-burdened

Impact at Home

Over 25,900 households with disabilities are housing-cost burdened and fall below the ALICE threshold, meaning that they are most likely struggling in other areas of financial security as well

Access to Services

Self-care difficulty and cognitive disabilities are the two highest groups to fall into the ALICE threshold
