### A SINGLE MOTHER IN CRISIS

After losing her job and unable to manage the bills piling up, a single mom and her two children were evicted from their apartment. With nowhere to go, they were forced to live in their car. After reaching out for help, this mom was connected to a United Way funded partner who assisted her in applying for an Emergency Housing Voucher.

With the voucher she found temporary housing and moved into a safe, secure two-bedroom apartment with her kids. She was beyond grateful for her family to have a stable environment. This housing stability gave her a new lease on life and was the catalyst for her to find full-time employment, regain independence and have a better quality of life for her and her children.
