 - Go on the Internet to <u>www.myfreetaxes.com</u> to complete your return on your own for no charge if it is a simple return.
 - If your tax return requires other forms that the above site will not process for free, there is a commercially free tax site to file federal income taxes on the internet. This site is www.freetaxusa.com and it guides you through the process.
 - Use tax preparation software such as Turbo Tax or Tax Wise that can be purchased at BJ's, Office Depot, and Staples. These programs will guide you step by step and are easy to use for simpler returns.
 - Wait until at least April 1 and call the United Way information line at 211or 386-253-0564 for a status of area VITA sites. PLEASE, DO NOT CALL OR VISIT THE __(location of site)_____AS THEY WILL NOT HAVE THE STATUS
 - Use a paid commercial tax preparation service.
- It is a possibility that the IRS will likely be extending the due date for filing beyond April 15. Go to www.irs.gov for the latest information.
